









Burner Supply Tube Compression Fitting Nuts

We have received complaints from several customers that the burner supply tube compression fitting nuts have cracked on some units after a season or two of use. These are the fittings that connect the low pressure copper tube to the burner. The cracks are developing as a result of thermal stress in severe environments.

As a result, Algas-SDI has initiated the use of a heavier duty compression fitting and nut. The new nut requires the use of a 13/16" open-end wrench or flare-nut wrench for servicing, whereas the previous nut required a 5/8" wrench. The new nut has an increased wall thickness of 0.10"

The manufacturing effective date is April 1, 2004 for all units.
